Bio Digester and Reed bed Toilets

Aasraa has installed two biodigester toilets at two school sites. These experimental toilets are to treat waste matter and create potable water which can be recycled for both cleaning and gardening purposes. A vertical organic garden is planned to allow the children to grow their own vegetables and actively understand the nature of reusing and recycling waste and finding green solutions.

Wings of Doon

The Wings of Doon program will provide after school conceptual and curriculum support to children who live in slums. In their homes they have no desks to study at, no lamps to read under and no one to answer their questions when they don't understand something. The children of this program are first-generation learners and they come from backgrounds of little or no schooling. It is imperative to provide remedial support to keep a pace with the school curriculum. Nutrition and medical care are also integral parts of the proposed program.

Online Teaching using Aasraa Ed Phones



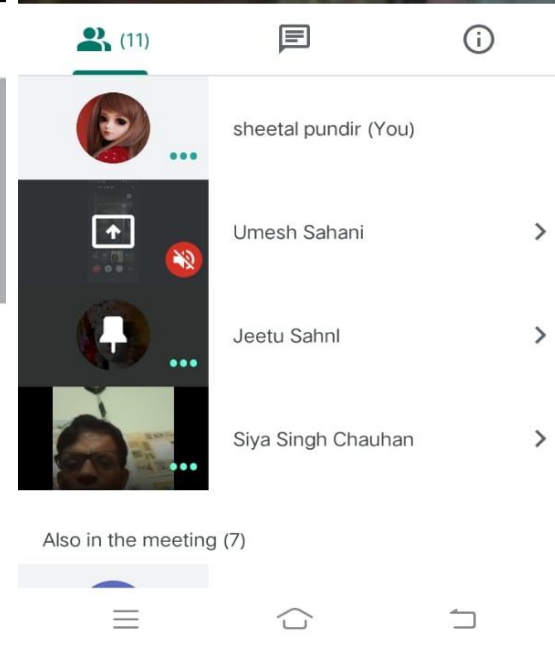
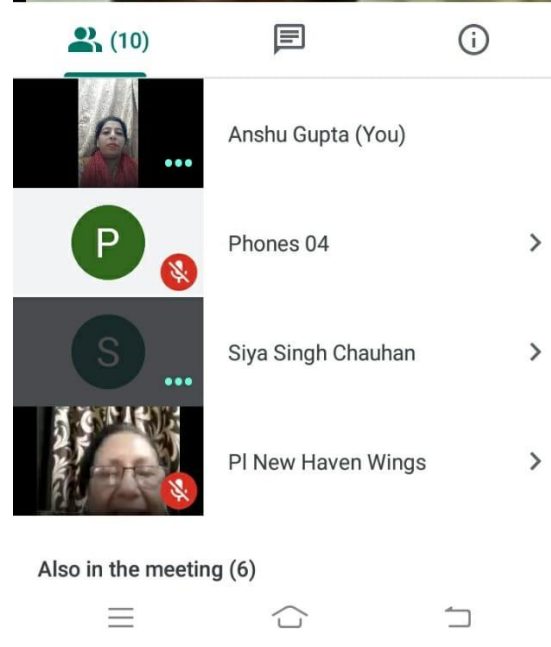
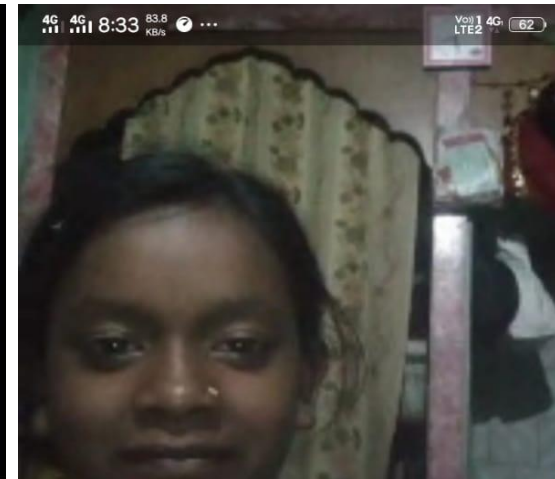


The project has been able to achieve the unthinkable thanks to the donors who have contributed whole heartedly for the **244 phones and tabs** given to connect **2233** students and educators.

New Initiatives: Rangeet App

Project Rangeet equips anyone aged 15+ with a mobile app based Social Emotional and Ecological Knowledge (SEEK) platform to develop 8-13 year old children into better all round learners and more successful, well-adjusted adults.

Adapted to different cultures and languages.



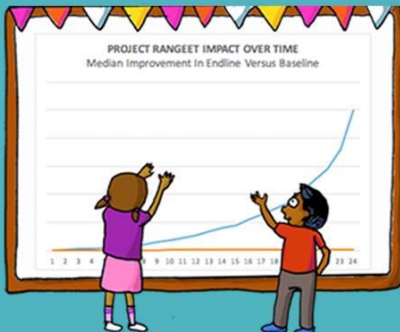
Content available via a mobile app. Requires minimum preparation. Anyone 15+ can be a teacher.



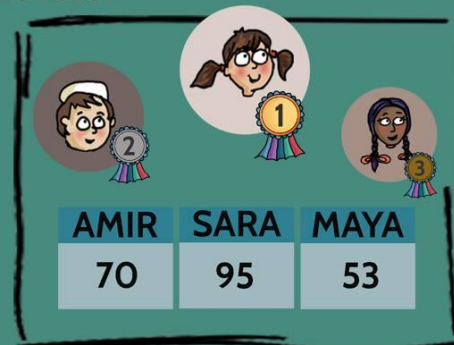
Monitors, verifies and geotags lessons taught; tracks funds spent, providing transparent reporting to administrators and donors.



Measures the impact on children via baseline / endline tests in real time.



Gamifies the teaching-learning process.



One device is needed to teach a student, a group or a class. Students do not need a device.
